EU AfT strategy (2007)

Objective of EU Aid for Trade strategy: Support to integration of partner countries in the world trading system with a view to <u>help reduce poverty</u>

- 1. Quantitative ambitions (pledges)
- 2. Pro-poor focus and quality

(context globalisation)

- 3. Strengthen EU capacity (aid effectiveness)
- 4. ACP specific context (EPA and regional integration)
- 5. Monitoring and reporting

Why focus on regional level?

EC COM on Regional integration of ACP countries (Oct. 08)

Reasons for a <u>regional</u> focus:

- Harness globalisation
- Positive EU experience
- Existing strategies in the ACP
- Long standing focus (Lomé and Cotonou)

Objectives of regional integration

- Political stability
- Economic development
- Regional public goods (connectivity, food security natural resources management, pest control etc.)



AfT and regional focus

EuropeAid

Areas of intervention:

- Strengthen regional institutions =>
- Building regional markets
- Support business development => Aid for Trade
- Connect infrastructure networks =>
- Regional policy for sustainable development



Challenges for AfT delivery

- -> Ownership of regions
- -> Weak capacities of RECs
- -> Multi-sectoral strategies
- -> Donor co-ordination, division of labour
- -> Subsidiarity







EuropeAid

Possible solutions:

- Enhance policy dialogue at regional level (EC-REC)
- Involve Member states, other donors, EIF, "EU Aid for Trade packages" -> joint programming and delivery
- Create a nexus between regional and national level
- Use locally owned instruments
- Focus on institution-building
